**Association Info:** Dose not display an address heading or provide a generic email address for the organization. The Goggle map icon when clicked opens a new window properly and displays only the address location, nothing about SSCA.

**Association Contacts:** The list of contacts has missing members and functions. The use of personal emails should be disallowed as a public inquiry email should be retained by the organization along with any official response from an office holder. Provides continuity and historical record of issues and eases transition of office holders when change occurs as a result of elections – newly elected members would have access to historical information of their predecessors. Email addresses should be selectable to facilitate ease of use to encourage inputs from the public – by using image based emails you minimize one set of problems (nefarious harvesters), but create additional effort and inconvenience on the general public to initiate an email. It is a pro/con dilemma – but it is usually a better practice to inconvenience yourself (potential spam) and convenience the public to easily initiate an email to you – you decide. The table listed below is a recommended starting point, add to, modify, and change as desired. Commodore or Associate should precede names of individuals as appropriate – not aware of each status.
